DAYS / MONTHS / SEASONS

DAYS of the WEEK

VOCABULARIES	PRONUNCIATION	MEANING
Lundi	[lun di]	Monday
Mardi	[ma r di]	Tuesday
Mercredi	[mè r kre di]	Wednesday
Jeudi	[je di]	Thursday
Vendredi	[van dre di]	Friday
Samedi	[sa me di]	Saturday
Dimanche	[di man ch]	Sunday

HOW TO USE

If there is **no ARTICLE** before a **NOUN** expressing a day of the week,
then it means that you are referring to **this specific day ONLY**.

Ex : “ **- Lundi**, je vais au cinéma”.

“On Monday (this specific Monday only), I go to the cinema.”

But if you put the **ARTICLE 'Le'** before a **NOUN** expressing a day of the week,
then it means that you are referring to **something that you do on a regular basis..**

Ex : “ **Le Lundi**, je vais au cinéma”.

“On Mondays, I regularly go to the cinema .”

MONTHS of the YEAR

VOCABULARIES	PRONUNCIATION	MEANING
Janvier	[jan vi é]	January
Février	[fé vri é]	February
Mars	[ma r s]	March
Avril	[a vri l]	April
Mai	[mè]	May
Juin	[ju un]	June
Juillet	[ju i yè]	July
Août	[ou t]	August
Septembre	[sè p tan br]	September
Octobre	[o k tô b r]	October
Novembre	[no van b r]	November
Décembre	[dé san b r]	December

HOW TO USE

We must put **“En”** before MONTH of the year

Ex : “ **En Janvier**, je vais en France.

“**In** January, I go to France.”

In order to talk about the different **parts of the month** :

Début Juin	[dé bu ju un]	Early June
Mi-Juin	[mi ju un]	Mid-June
Fin Juin	[fun ju un]	Late June

SEASONS		
VOCABULARIES	PRONUNCIATION	MEANING
L'été	[lé té]	Summer
L'automne	[lo tô n]	Autumn
L'hiver	[li vè r]	Winter
Le printemps	[le prun tan]	Spring

When referring to **the SEASON itself** (the noun) use the article **"Le"**

Example : J'aime l'été. (I like summer.)

HOW TO USE		
En été	[an né té]	In summer
En automne	[an no tô n]	In autumn
En hiver	[an ni vè r]	In winter
Au printemps	[o prun tan]	In spring

When referring to **the PERIOD OF THE YEAR**, use the preposition **"En"**

Example : En été, je vais à la plage. (In summer, I go to the beach.)

When referring to **the PERIOD OF THE YEAR during SPRING**, use **"Au"**

Example : Au printemps, je vais à la piscine. (In summer, I go to the beach.)
