EXPLANTATIONS

« **Il y a** » In French, means « **There is / There are** » in English

Unlike most of the words in French, « **il y a** » is NOT affected by :

- GENDERS (**M**asculin / **F**éminin)
- NUMBERS (**S**ingulier / **P**luriel)

It means that whatever the phrase « **il y a** » refers to,
it will always be **spelled the same way**.

VOCABULARY	PRONUNCIATION	MEANING
Il y a un chat.	[i li ya un cha]	There is a (male) cat.
Il y a une chatte.	[i li ya u n cha t]	There is a (female) cat.
Il y a des chats.	[i li ya dé cha]	There are some (male) cats.
Il y a des chattes.	[i li ya dé cha t]	There are some (female) cats.

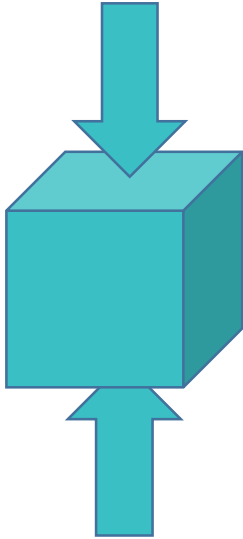
