Je	cherch	e	[chè r ch]	I look for
Tu	cherch	es	[chè r ch]	You look for
Il / Elle	cherch	e	[chè r ch]	He / She looks for
Nous	cherch	ons	[chè r chon]	We look for
Vous	cherch	ez	[chè r ché]	You look for
Ils / Elles	cherch	ent	[chè r ch]	They look for

	TROUV	ER	[trou vé]	TO FIND
Je	trouv	e	[trou v]	I find
Tu	trouv	es	[trou v]	You find.
Il / Elle	trouv	e	[trou v]	He / She finds.
Nous	trouv	ons	[trou von]	We find.
Vous	trouv	ez	[trou vé]	You find.
Ils / Elles	trouv	ent	[trou v]	They find.

Inviter

[un vi té]

To invite

Tu **invites** tes amis.

Arriver

[a ri vé]

To arrive

Il **arrive** au cinéma.

[i la ri v ...]

He arrives at the cinema.

Saluer

[sa lu é]

To greet / To wave

Elle **salue** son professeur.

[è l sa lu ...]

She greets her teacher.

Discuter

[di s ku té]

To discuss

Nous **discutons** au parc.

[nou di s ku ton ...]

We discuss at the park.

Bavarder

[ba va r dé]

To chat

Vous **bavardez** à la maison.

[vou ba va r dé ...]

You chat at home.

Commander

[ko man dé]

To order

Ils **commandent** un café.

[i l ko man d ...]

They order a coffee.

Poser

[po zé]

To put (down)

Tu **poses** ton livre.

Montrer

[mon tré]

To show

Il **montre** un gâteau.

[i l mon t r ...]

He shows a cake.

Regarder

[re gar dé]

To watch / To look at

Elle **regarde** la plante.

[è l re gar d ...]

She looks at the plant.

Ecouter

[é kou té]

To listen

Nous **écoutons** la musique.

[nou zé kou ton ...]

We listen to the music.

Changer

[chan jé]

To change

Vous **changez** votre lit.

[vou chan jé ...]

You change your bed.

Décider

[dé si dé]

To decide

Elles **décident**.

[è l dé si d]

They decide.

[ré vi zé]

To review

Il **révise** ce document.

[i l ré vi z ...]

He **reviews** this document.

Pratiquer

[pra ti ké]

To practice

Elle **pratique**.

[è l pra ti k]

She **practices**.

Essayer

[è sè yé]

To try

Nous **essayons**.

[nou è sè yon]

We **try**.

Gagner

[ga ni é]

To win

Vous **gagnez**.

[vou ga ni é]

You **win**.

Visiter

[vi zi té]

To visit (a place)

Ils **visitent** cette école.

[i l vi zi t ...]

They **visit** this school.
