ADVERBS OF QUANTITY

INTRODUCTION

ADVERBS of QUANTITY

are used to describe **how much** the action of the **VERB** is done.

(ex : « ... **ate** a bit » / « ... **travels** a lot » / « ... **work** too much »)

Like regular **ADVERBS**, you should placed them after the **(FIRST) VERB**

FRENCH	PRONUNCIATION	ENGLISH
Un peu	[un pe]	A bit

Il travaille **un peu** le matin.

(He works **a bit** in the morning.)

Assez	[a sé]	Enough
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Ils dorment **assez**.

(They sleep **enough**.)

Beaucoup	[bo kou]	A lot
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Je vais **beaucoup** voyager.

(I will travel **a lot**.)

Trop	[tro]	Too
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Il a **trop** travaillé.

(He worked **too much**.)

ADVERBS OF QUANTITY + ADJECTIVES

ADVERBS of QUANTITY,

can also be associated with an **ADJECTIF**

to describe the way someone or something is.

(ex : « ... **too tired**. » / « ... **a bit far**. » / « ... **quite friendly**. »)

ADVERBS should be placed just before the **ADJECTIVES**.

FRENCH	PRONUNCIATION	ENGLISH
Un peu	[un pe]	A bit

Il est **un peu** fatigué.

(He is **a bit** tired.)

Assez	[a sé]	Enough / Quite
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Elles sont **assez** contentes.

(They are **quite** happy.)

Trop	[tro]	Too
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Il est **trop** méchant.

(He is **too** mean.)



QUANTITY / AMOUNT

In order to express the **QUANTITY / AMOUNT**,
you can use the **vocabularies** we just learned and add :

... « de » + **NOUN**

Example : J'ai **beaucoup de chiens**. (I have **a lot of dogs**.)

FRENCH	PRONUNCIATION	ENGLISH
Un peu de + nom	[un pe de]	A bit of

J'ai **un peu de** chocolat.

(I have **a bit of** chocolate.)

Assez de + nom	[a sé de]	Enough
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Ils ont **assez de** temps.

(They have **enough** time.)

Beaucoup de + nom	[bo kou de]	A lot of
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J'ai **beaucoup de** chiens.

(I have **a lot of** dogs.)

Trop de + nom	[tro de]	Too much / Too many
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Il mange **trop de** croissants.

(He eats **too many** croissants.)
