QUESTIONS (Part 5)

INTRODUCTION

In this lesson, we are going to focus on
the **FIFTH** and last way to ask a question..

We will continue using
“**Quel / Quelle / Quels / Quelles**”

But in this case,
we are going to **combine** them with **the verb “ÊTRE” (to be)**,
like in English when you ask :

« **What is** ... ? »

« **What are** ... ? »

Let's have a look to a few examples :

QUESTION TYPE 5		When you want to say “What is...?” or “What are...?”	
What	To be	Noun	Object
Quel	est	le nom	de ton chat?
[kè l]	[è]	[le non]	[de ton cha]
What	is	the name	of your cat?
Quelle	est	la taille	de ton teeshirt?
[kè l]	[è]	[la ta y]	[de ton ti cheu r t]
What	is	the size	of your teeshirt?
Quels	sont	tes plats	préférés?
[kè l]	[son]	[té pla]	[pré fé ré]
What	are	your « dishes	favourite »?
Quelles	sont	ses séries	préférées?
[kè l]	[son]	[sé sé ri]	[pré fé ré]
What	are	his / her « series	favourite »?

The spelling of “**Quel / Quelle / Quels / Quelles**”
depends on the **gender** & the **number** of the noun it refers to :

Quel	[kè l]	➡	Nom	= Masculin / Singulier
Quelle	[kè l]	➡	Taille	= Féminin / Singulier
Quels	[kè l]	➡	Plats	= Masculin / Pluriel
Quelles	[kè l]	➡	Séries	= Féminin / Pluriel
