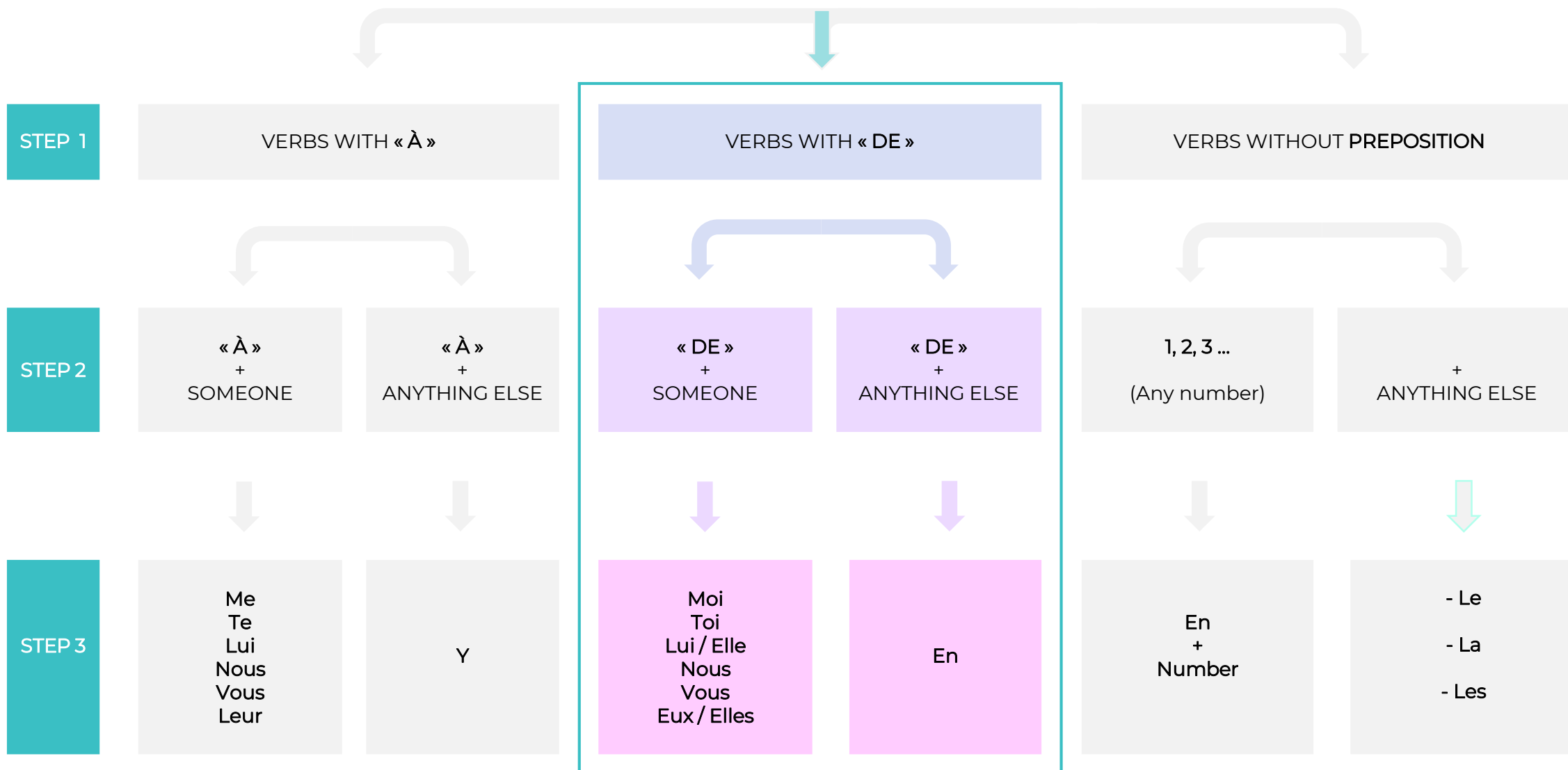
INTRODUCTION

In this lesson, we are going to focus on the **SECOND WAY** to use these **pronouns**.

It is based on the following structure:

VERB + « DE »

Let's take a look:



CASE #1: VERB + « DE » + SOMEONE:

When referring to **SOMEONE**, use the following PRONOUNS:

SUBJECT	PRONOUN	VERB	DE	SOMEONE	MEANING
Je		parle	de	mon frère.	I talk about my brother.
Je		parle.	de	lui.	I talk about him.

SUBJECT	PRONOUN	VERB	DE	SOMEONE	MEANING
Je		parle	de	moi.	I talk about me.
Je		parle	de	toi.	I talk about you.
Je		parle	de / d'	lui. / elle	I talk about him. / her.
Je		parle	de	nous.	I talk about us.
Je		parle	de	vous.	I talk about you.
Je		parle	de / d'	eux. / elles.	I talk about them.

CASE #2: VERB + « DE » + ANYTHING ELSE

When referring to **ANYTHING ELSE**, use the PRONOUN: « EN » [an]

SUBJECT	PRONOUN	VERB	DE	OBJECT	MEANING
Je		mange	du	gâteau.	I eat (some) cake.
Je		mange	de la	tarte.	I eat (some) pie.
Je		mange	des	biscuits.	I eat (some) biscuits.
J'	en	mange.			I eat some.
