OBJECT PRONOUNS (Part 3)

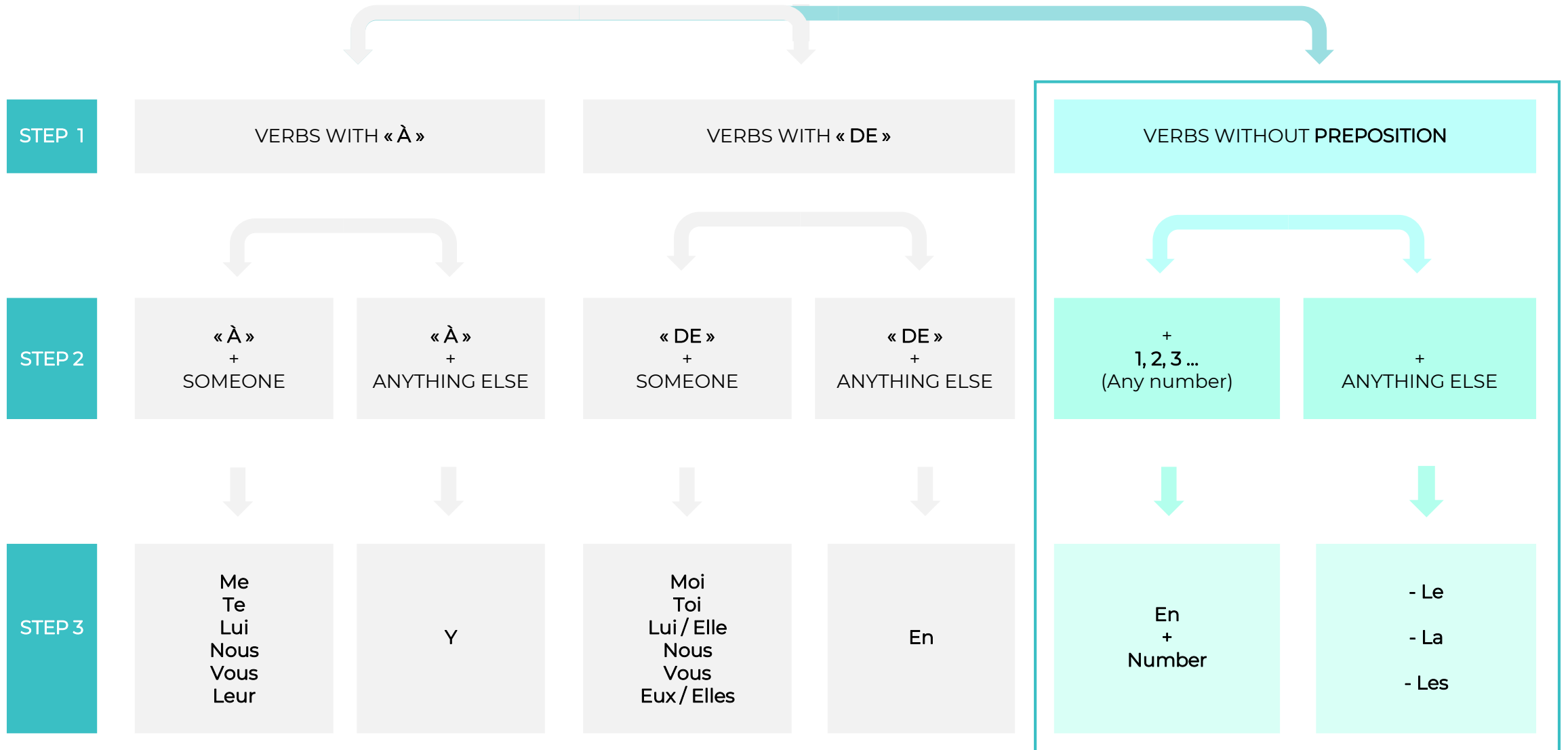
INTRODUCTION

In this lesson, we are going to focus on the **LAST WAY** to use these **pronouns**.

It is based on the following structure:

VERB without PREPOSITION

Let's take a look:



CASE #1: VERB + ANY NUMBER

When referring to any NUMBER, use the following PRONOUNS:

SUBJECT	PRONOUN	VERB	DE	OBJECT	MEANING
Je		mange	un	gâteau.	I eat one / a cake.
Je		mange	deux	gâteaux.	I eat two cakes.
Je		mange	trois	gâteaux.	I eat three cakes.

J'	en	mange	un.		I eat one .
J'	en	mange	deux.		I eat two .
J'	en	mange.	trois.		I eat three .

CASE #2: VERB + ANYTHING ELSE

When referring to ANYTHING ELSE, use : « LE » / « LA » / « LES »

SUBJECT	PRONOUN	VERB	DE	OBJECT	MEANING
Je		mange	le mon ce ...	gâteau.	I eat the my this cake.
Je	le	mange.			I eat it.

Je		mange	la ma cette ...	tarte.	I eat the my this pie.
Je	la	mange.			I eat it.

Je		mange	les mes ces ...	biscuits.	I eat the my these biscuits.
Je	les	mange.			I eat them.
